- 5. The head coach must serve as an appropriate role model for student athletes through his/her instructions and actions.

REPORTS TO: The athletic director, who provides overall objectives and final evaluation in conjunction with the high school principal.

JOB GOAL: To instruct athletes in the fundamental skills, strategy and physical training necessary for them to realize a degree of individual and team success. At the same time, the coach must instruct and demonstrate behaviors that lead to socially acceptable character development, self discipline, self confidence, and pride of accomplishment in the student athletes. To upgrade his/her knowledge and skills through coaching clinics, observations, consultation, etc.

- As a head coach, it is your responsibility to lead ALL student-athletes in the program. It is also up to you to communicate with the assistant coaches by letting them know what you expect from them and their role within the program.
- As an assistant coach, it is your responsibility to follow the directions of the head coach by asking what
  roles and duties the head coach wants you to do, what plays/drills to teach and constantly seek to
  improve on technical and tactical knowledge of the sport. Assistant coaches should make sure they
  understand what the head coach wants to accomplish and use their initiative/resources to help get it
  done.
- Always set good examples for others by modeling effective habits.
- Instruct the players in their sportsmanship responsibilities.
- Discipline players who display unsportsmanlike behavior, as well as, violations of school, athletic & CHSAA rules/regulations.
- Be a good host to the opponent. Treat them as guests.
- Respect the officials' judgements and interpretations of the rules.
- Adhere to ALL eligibility rules, as well as, state, league rules and school rules.
